Colonel William "Bill" Green is currently assigned as the Vice Commander 146th Airlift Wing, Channel Islands Air National Guard Station, California. He is responsible of the effective execution of the 146 AW mission in support of local, state and federal authorities. Colonel Green also commands the Headquarters Staff which encompasses Staff Judge Advocate, Inspector General, Chaplains, Safety, Comptroller Flight, Military Equal Opportunity, Information Protection, Public Affairs, Plans and Programs, Command Post, and State Military Reserves.

Colonel Green was commissioned through the Academy of Military Science at McGhee Tyson ANG Base, Tennessee in February 1992 and graduated from undergraduate pilot training at Vance AFB, Oklahoma in 1993 prior to returning to the 146th Airlift Wing to fly C-130s in the California ANG.

Colonel Green is a command pilot with more than 6,000 military and civilian flying hours in the C-130J, WC-130J, EC-130J, C-130E, B-787, S80, B727, T-38, T-37 and T-41 aircraft. He has accrued over 400 combat hours in the tactical environment in support of multiple deployments to include Operations Coronet Oak, Southern Watch, Joint Endeavor, Joint Enterprise, Joint Forge, Noble Eagle, Iraqi Freedom, and Enduring Freedom. Prior to his current assignment he served as the Director of Operations, California Air National Guard at Joint Force Headquarters, Sacramento, California.
